Dear Parents/Carers

On Thursday 10th and Friday 11th October your son/daughter will be taking part in the Year 7 residential trip to Croft Farm near Tewkesbury. We will be leaving school by coach at 9.00am on Thursday, please provide a packed lunch for Thursday (if your child is entitled to a free school meal packed lunch will be provided). We will travel to Croft Farm via coach and upon arrival will take part in our first planned activity. The evening meal on Thursday will be provided at Croft Farm, as will breakfast on Friday morning and lunch later in the day. We will be back at Pittville by end of school Friday.

Your child will need to bring a sleeping bag and a pillow as well as an overnight bag, including a towel. During the activities, children will need old clothes to wear (including a set of old clothes for Saturday) and will also need to bring some old footwear that they don't mind getting wet. It is advisable to pack a plastic bag for the children's wet clothes to go into.

Students will take part water-based activities on both days. Your child does not need to bring any money with them.
