That's why this year, as we celebrate Pittville's 30th anniversary, I would like to build on the school's progress and success by making fundraising one of the key priorities for the school as part of our wider school development plan. And of course, to do this I need your support.

Let's set up a school fund for a better learning environment for all

A corner stone of my plan is to introduce a School Fund to raise money that will only be used to help the school community. It's something that many other schools do to great effect. My hope is that as many parents and carers *who are able to*, will contribute a few pounds to this fund each month to benefit students here at Pittville.

How we could spend our School Fund

The funds raised *won't* be spent to assist in the provision of things normally provided by the Local Education Authority. They will be used to provide many 'extra's which could enhance students' learning experience. These are my priorities:

- create more social spaces for students
- create multi-use games areas
- fund outdoor table tennis tables and table football facilities
- fund a second minibus
- support bids from faculties such as Design Technology, Performing Arts and PE
- continue to improve ICT facilities.
