**Performing Arts New York Tour: 10<sup>th</sup> – 15<sup>th</sup> February 2022**

Pittville School Performing Arts department are running a trip to New York in February 2022. This trip is for students who will be in year 9, 10 or 11 taking a performing arts subject at GCSE. This trip is a wonderful, once in a lifetime opportunity to explore the theatres of Broadway as well as take in some key tourist locations.

An approximate itinerary is as follows:

- 4 nights' accommodation on Madison Square Gardens
- Empire State Building tour
- Ferry to Liberty and Ellis Island tour
- Broadway theatre tickets
- Broadway tailored workshop with actors and industry professionals
- 9/11 memorial tour
- Shopping trip to Macy's
- All evening meals included at some iconic New York restaurants
- Ice skating in Central Park
- Shopping in Time Square
- Visits to New York locations such as Grand Central Station, The New York Library, The Rockefeller Centre, Trump Tower and Radio City.

An approximate costing for this trip will be £1700, spread over monthly instalments on Parent Pay. Cost is approximate and may change due to fluctuation in exchange rate, price increases or decreases and interest rates.

The trip is open to KS4 students who have chosen a Performing Arts subject and will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. If you would like your child to be a part of the trip, please make the initial deposit payment of £150 by 20<sup>th</sup> November and a second deposit payment of £150, by 18<sup>th</sup> December. The payment schedule is as follows:
