The governors are seeking to appoint a dynamic, enthusiastic leader of our RE department. In the first instance we are looking for a January 2022 start but we would agree to a later start date if necessary. This post arises as a result of the retirement of our current curriculum leader. The successful candidate will have a clear vision of how the teaching of RE should develop over the next few years. They will be able to implement a challenging curriculum at KS3 that motivates our pupils and secure good progress for our KS4 students. They will be able to work well as part of team and have the management skills to ensure the smooth day to day running of the department.

The RE department is well-equipped with two specialist RE teaching rooms. RE is an important part of life at Pittville School equipping students with knowledge and understanding of different religions and beliefs, to allow them to contribute to a diverse society. RE plays an important part in preparing students for adult life and becoming responsible citizens, upholding British values. The post holder will work closely with the RHSE co-ordinator to sequence an effective personal development curriculum across key stages 3 and 4. The role involves having accountability for curriculum provision, delivery and outcomes at Key Stage 3 and 4. There is the opportunity to further develop the provision at KS4.

Pittville School is a good 11-16 school situated in a superb setting in the heart of Cheltenham. We are oversubscribed at KS3 in September 2022. In June 2019 Ofsted said stated that standards they attain are rising year on year and we are particularly proud that visitors to our school always comment on the excellent behaviour and attitude to learning exhibited by our pupils. We are part of the Balcarras Teaching Hub partnership which provides a range of continual professional development opportunities in addition to those offered at Pittville.

We think this is a fantastic opportunity for an experienced teacher to join our school at a very exciting time in our development and contribute to the further success of religious education at Pittville.
