

Year 11 Transition Work

As a result of the pandemic, year 11 students have suffered a certain amount of disruption in their final year and we recognise they may not feel as well-prepared for their post-16 places as students have in the past. We therefore have a package of transition materials in place that students can access once they have completed their assessments and are no longer attending school.

There is no need, and no expectation that students will access everything we post. The idea is that students pick those materials that will support them to the next level of their studies. Here is a guide to selecting the right materials:

■ For students studying A levels or level 3 BTECS or diplomas next year:

- Subject teachers will provide materials covering any areas of the curriculum that weren't covered as a result of the disruption
- They may also provide extension work or suggested reading to support transition to post-16.

The table below shows which subject materials students should consider accessing. For example, it is obvious that French materials are useful for going on to study French A level, but for students studying PE or H&SC it is worth accessing the science materials, or for business studies or computing, it is worth accessing the maths materials.

- We are providing some literacy and numeracy materials for those not expected to reach grade 4 in English and/or maths
- For students studying the following subjects at level 2 we would also recommend accessing the materials suggested above for the Level 3 students: *business, enterprise, H&SC, childcare, early years, media, sport, performing arts, music, art, photography, catering, hospitality, engineering, construction, motor vehicle, event planning, travel and tourism, flight crew.*

■ **Links to Post-16 Providers**
