

Year 11 Transition Work

We are aware that as a result of the disruption to your education in years 10 and 11 you may not feel as well-prepared for your post-16 places as students have in the past. We have therefore put together a package of transition materials for you to access once you have completed your year 11 assessments and are no longer attending school. We hope you will find these useful, and also remind you that we are still available for help and support right up until you start at your next placement.

You do need to, and are not expected to use everything we post. Here is a guide to finding what you need.

■ If you are studying A levels or level 3 BTECS or diplomas next year:

- Your subject teachers will provide materials covering any areas of the curriculum that weren't covered as a result of the disruption
- They may also provide extension work or suggested reading to support transition to post-16.

The table below shows which subject materials you should consider accessing. For example, it is obvious that you may want to access French materials if you are doing French A level, but if you have chosen PE or H&SC it is worth accessing the science materials, or if you are taking business studies or computing, it is worth accessing the maths materials.

- We will provide some literacy and numeracy materials for those not expected to reach grade 4 in English and/or maths
- If you are taking the following subjects at level 2 we would also recommend accessing the materials suggested above for the Level 3 students: *business, enterprise, H&SC, childcare, early years, media, sport, performing arts, music, art, photography, catering, hospitality, engineering, construction, motor vehicle, event planning, travel and tourism, flight crew.*
