

**APPLICATION FOR A
SCHOOL UNIFORM GRANT
Academic Year 2026/2027**



School Uniform Grant

Students from low-income families transferring to secondary education (i.e. into Year 7) are entitled to receive support with their uniform costs.

Who is eligible?

If your child is transferring into Year 7 in September 2026 and is currently entitled to **free school meals**, they will also be entitled to a School Uniform Grant.

The grant is paid as a contribution towards the costs of your child's school uniform. Successful applications will be issued with a voucher.

This grant is a one-off payment and does not have to be paid back. However, if it was found that a grant has been claimed fraudulently then we will require a full amount of the grant to be returned.

How does it work?

You can apply for this grant after you have accepted your child's place at Pittville School.

Once you have completed your application form, which can be found below, you need to return it to Mrs Haidon, Finance, Pittville School. Please note, failure to complete the form in full will delay your claim and issue of the voucher.

How long does it take?

Closing date for applications is 8th July 2026. If you are entitled to a grant, you will receive a letter confirming after this date and a voucher will be included. If you have indicated that you wish to have a voucher for Batemans uniform supplier, you will receive this voucher ahead of their sales day at Pittville School on Saturday 18th July 2026 between 10am and 2pm.

This form should only be completed if you wish to apply for a School Uniform Grant for your child.

Pittville School has two suppliers of our school uniform;

- **Monkhouse Schoolwear, 252 High Street, Cheltenham.** A voucher for this supplier will be issued for you to take to the shop and present as a contribution towards the costs of school uniform.
- **Batemans, 2 Kendrick Street, Stroud, GL51AB.** A voucher for this supplier will be issued for you either take to the shop, order at the event at school on 18th July 2026 or online as a contribution towards the costs of school uniform. You can choose to have your order delivered to your home address or delivered for free to school for collection in August 2026.
